Well, speaking of "life goes on," I must let you know (if you don't already know) that my dear friend, **Ike Foster** passed away in Korea. They had a funeral service in Korea. To me, Ike Foster isn't just an ordinary missionary or friend. **He was like a dad to me.** I met him when I was stationed in Japan during the World War II occupation of Japan. Ike was the pioneer missionary to Japan, and then the pioneer missionary to Korea. He was one of the first missionaries to Japan after the war and continued all these years. In fact, that is why I live. I'll be 80 this year, but I haven't slowed down and plan on staying busy for our Lord until He comes for all of us, or for me. Either way is okay with me.
