I consider them brave missionaries to be there and to help those in need with physical needs as well as giving out Bibles, N.T. and tracts. My prayer is that this terrible disaster will bring the Japanese to flee to their one source of real help, the Lord Jesus Christ. Please pray for Japan. Pray also that Churches will see the need to support me.
