

Dear Fellow Missionaries, Pastors & Friends:

"Better late than never" is what I've been told, so this prayer letter is later than ever. I received a call from some very close friends of my sister Flora. They love Flora so much that they wanted to buy my airline ticket to see my sister who has terminal colon cancer. Flora and my other sister Peggy both live in Quakertown, just north of Philly (where I was born). In addition to seeing Flora and Peggy, I was asked to preach in their church, the Bethel Baptist Church. I am indeed thankful to Rich & Diane Clark for paying my way there and for having me stay in their home and for all the meals Diane cooked for me while there. Diane has a tremendous desire for those who have lost a spouse, so she bought a number of my books entitled "No More Tears." They would like to see a Precious Memories Support Ministry started in their church. Please pray for my sister Flora. She is on chemo and that is very hard on her. I am thankful that Flora and Peggy both are saved.



In just about 2 months from now I will be on my way to Japan to preach all over Japan. I thank Phil Melugin, President and CEO of Pheonix Home Care & my long time friend for paying for my airline tickets. On the way to Japan, I will stop in Los Angeles to preach 4 times in the Fundamentalist Baptist Tabernacle for Dr. R.L.

Hymers Jr. It is a thrill to preach in that great church in the heart of downtown L.A. I have two interpreters there: Chinese and Spanish. Dr. Hymer's messages are translated into 19 foreign languages. You can read them on his website (www.realconversion.com). After preaching there I will continue on to Hawaii where I will preach in Bro. Steve Wygle's church and in a Japanese pastor's church for Bro. Kamikubo, a Japanese missionary. So I'll be preaching in English and in Japanese. This will be a great opportunity. I will also get to see Mayumi Sekiya, a young Japanese lady who graduated from Baptist Bible College with two master's degrees. She is doing her internship in Hawaii. She was a great blessing in my Japanese church while in BBC. After about a week there, I will wing my flight on to Japan where I will be preaching in many churches scattered all over Japan. I am buying a train "rail-pass" that will allow me to ride the trains anywhere at any time to get to those churches. Please pray for this up-coming trip which starts March 27.

As for my Japanese ministry here in Springfield, things are going great. Services are in full swing. I am preaching through the Book of the Revelation on Sunday evenings. Right now I'm in Rev. 14 and it's my 42nd lesson. It takes much time getting the lessons up in Japanese. During Sunday School, I am teaching various subjects that help with the problems of daily life. On Thursdays we have the Ladies Bible Study. Once or twice a month the Japanese children come for what they call "KODOMO-KAI." Once a month the Precious Memories Support Ministry meets for a luncheon and a time to fellowship with others who have lost a spouse. Also, I am very much involved in the SOS Soulwinning Ministry.
