Years ago I taught it, but it took 38 Sundays. Narrowing it down to just 7 Sundays was a real challenge. I chose 7 Sundays because 7 is predominate in the Revelation. I thank Pastor Gary Longstaff for asking me to do that. I consider it to be one of the greatest blessings in all of my ministry.

Our Japanese ministry continues to go on despite my health problems. The Corona virus pandemic has not stopped us. Of course, I have to make sure the tables and chairs are sanitized before each service and we do wear those silly masks. (I have never gone into a church with a mask on before this virus thing.) During my Revelation series, I mentioned how easy it will be for the Antichrist to cause everyone to take the "mark of the beast," since we are already programed to comply with such orders. But we Christians need not worry. We won't be here then. I say, "Amen, Even so, come, Lord Jesus."
